Fabric Angel

What you need:

- Two different size circles to trace around
- Tinsel, pipe cleaners or craft wire
- Thread or string
- [™] Ribbon
- Cotton balls or stuffing
- Craft eyes (optional)
- **Scissors**
- Fabric pen / marker pen



What to do:

- 1. Using two different size circles (use plates or bowls), cut one circle of each size from fabric for each angel. The larger circle is the body and the smaller circle the wings.
- 2. Put a cotton ball or small amount of stuffing in the middle of the large circle. Using a piece of thread, tie the material to make a head.
- Take the smaller circle, and tie tight a piece of thread in the middle to form wings. (This will make two fan shapes for the wings.) Tie the wings around neck of the body.
- 4. Take a piece of ribbon, and tie it around the neck to hide the thread. Make it into a bow.
- 5. Glue a halo, using tinsel, pipe cleaner or craft wire onto the head.
- 6. Tie a small loop of thread or ribbon to the back of the angel to hang.
- 7. (Optional) Add facial features by gluing eyes or drawing eyes & mouth on with fabric pen.
